STREET DANCE!

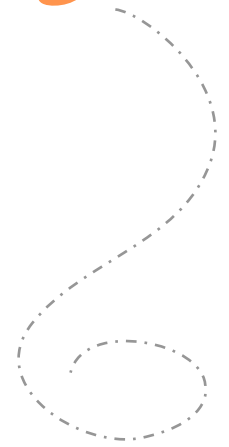

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW...

Hours of operation: 7:30am- 6:30pm.

Daily Fees: \$60 per day plus any extra costs for incursions or excursions.

Cancelations: Need to be made 48 hours prior to the booked day. Please let staff know via phone or email if you wish to cancel. Medical Certificates are accepted.

Absent Fee: If your child does not attend the session you have booked in for and you have not provided us with notification you will be charged the normal day fee, PLUS an additional \$10 absent fee.

Food: Breakfast will be provided daily.

What to Bring: Morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea, drink bottle, suitable clothing and footwear

What NOT to Bring: Nut Products (Inc. Nutella , peanut butter, nut bars), Kiwi fruit. These foods will be taken and your child will be given another lunch or snack option. Open toed shoes Inc. crocs or thongs

Personal Items: We do not take responsibility for personal items brought to the service. Inc. iPads, iPods, Beyblades ets.

Child Care Benefit (CCB) and Child Care Rebate (CCR): If you wish to claim CCB and CCR you must supply your family customer reference number (CRN) and your child's CRN details on their enrolment forms.

Behaviour: If a child's behaviour seriously affects the safety and wellbeing of others and/ or themselves, parents will be contacted to collect their child from the program.

Children with Additional Needs: We support children with additional needs. Please contact OSHC manager (Emma Renn) prior to the program starting. If additional resources or support is required it is asked you contact us as soon as possible.

Excursion Cancellations: In the event that an excursion or incursion is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances the activity will either be postponed or and alternative and equal value activity will be substituted where possible.
